III. GUEST SPEAKERS:

- a. Kent Runyon and Nikesha Yarbrough presented on impact of the opioid crisis and abuse in Florida. Reviewed state data and actions taken by the state-good Samaritan act, emergency treatment and Recovery Act. Also purpose of Naloxone and how Rx Committee wants to have a Naloxone town hall meeting to educate the community.

IV. Rebecca Socol from Evzio demonstrated the process of injecting Evzio which is Narcan for when someone overdoses. This is designed until first responders can get to the overdosed person. Reviewed process of obtaining the product and how to effectively get it to the needed population.

 - a. Nikesha Yarbrough updated that the Naloxone townhall is set for June and is going to work with Recovery Subcommittee on getting feedback on thoughts of overdoses and naloxone.
 - b. Provided pre and post test on Naloxone for ASAP meeting attendees to gauge everyone's knowledge of this.

 - a. Kellie Walker discussed that STAND youth are participating in Great American Clean Up.
- VII. MARIJUANA TASK FORCE:
 - a. Christina Roberto discussed recent medical marijuana news articles involving legislation, identification cards, and talking about marijuana with youth.
- VIII. LEGISLATIVE UPDATES
 - a. State legislative updates were given from Christina Roberto in regards to legislation regarding mental health, medical marijuana, alcohol, substance abuse, and tobacco.
 - i. Christina discussed there are currently two different marijuana bills that discuss different ways to implement Amendment 2.
 - ii. Christina discussed the Whiskey and Wheaties bill which will increase alcohol in grocery stores and have more opportunities for youth to have access.

 - a. 2017 ASAP Conference is scheduled for late September
 - b. TN24 will host a recovery concert to support those in recovery.
