- I. INTRODUCTIONS: Chrissie Parris, Chair, welcomed the group at 10:05. Introductions took place. Minutes were reviewed. There was a motion to approve by Renee Shelton-, PACE. There was a second motion to approve by Missy Coyle, BCBH-CHAT. Meeting minutes passed as presented.
- II. GUEST PRESENTER: Nikesha Yarbrough - Poison Control Center conducted a Presentation on Poison Center calls trends from E-Cigs and Edible Marijuana Products across the country and locally.
- III. MJ Say Don't Say: Shelah and Monica role played responses to typical questions asked during a presentations that include information on marijuana. They reviewed words to avoid when being asked questions on legislation and laws. They reviewed how to educate without lobbying.
- IV. Community Health and Wellness Committee: Chrissie has taken over as interim chair while the committee goes through a process to determine the goals and structure of the meeting. The next meeting will be a Consensus Workshop conducted by Tobacco Free Partnership's Georgia BriecK at Premier in Dade City. All are welcome to help set priorities and build an action plan around building the health of the community and integrating systems of care.
- V. Substance Exposed Newborns Committee: Missy and Liana introduced the new stigma project. Index sized cards will be strategically placed around the

community for people to leave words of encouragement to women of child bearing age struggling with addiction. The November meeting is cancelled.

VII. ASAP Business

- b. Rx Meeting – It has been decided to separate the Rx and SEN initiatives into two different meetings. The Rx meeting is the first Tuesday of the month at North Bay Hospital at 3:30pm.
- c. USF Students and AHEC Grant – ASAP was awarded an AHEC grant to continue the SEN project of educating providers. This project will be phase 2 and will focus on training doctors to screen women of childbearing age- not just pregnant women. The timeline is ambitious and the students are expected to start in the first part of 2016.
- d. #PascoPromise was a campaign kicked off on social media during prom season in the last school year. Students were encouraged to make a healthy promise and hashtag it on social media. The school district recently put together a video with students making a #PascoPromise. This is a great success!
